Class Description

America's Water Infrastructure... What? Is the first part of a two-part series on America's Water Infrastructure Act (AWIA). This law refines the Bio-terrorism Act of 2002. It requires systems to complete new risk assessments and emergency response plans. These are due in 2021 for systems serving populations greater than 3,300 people (not connections).

Although AWIA regulations only require community water systems to certify compliance under the law, wastewater and smaller water systems will also see a large benefit in following the standards set for assessments and emergency plans. In the first part, we will discuss the specifics of the law, who it applies to, why you might want to comply even if you're not required to and how to comply to avoid a potential fine of \$25,000/day to be assessed by the EPA.
