The district is the quasi-municipal wastewater utility serving the Town of Brunswick and provides treatment services for the Town of Topsham. The district is a technological and socially progressive and innovative entity govern by an appointed five-member Board of Trustees. The general manager reports to the Board of Trustees and directly supervises the assistant general manager and the finance manager.

The general manager has full responsibility for the entire operation of the utility and is responsible for carrying out the mission and vision, with commitment to its values. Must have the skills and experience to effectively manage executive, administrative, and operational personnel, as well as the financial, legal, and business responsibilities of a modern standard bearing public wastewater utility.
